Faith Build

What is a Faith Build?

A Faith Build is a partnership of Faith Communities working together to invest in our community. Together they raise \$69,000, provide volunteer labor and prayer support to build a Habitat for Humanity house in collaboration with a local family. Habitat for Humanity of Brevard County is a 501(c)3 nonprofit dedicated to eliminating sub-standard housing by building safe and affordable homes for low-income, hardworking families who cannot qualify for a conventional mortgage.

The Faith Community Provides

- Prayer** It is very much appreciated when all aspects of a Habitat build are bathed in prayer.
- Volunteers** Entire congregations are invited to participate with no previous construction skills needed. Our Volunteer Coordinator handles all the scheduling and managing of volunteers and provides all that is needed on the build day.
- Funding** Faith based organizations come together to raise a total of \$69,000 in financial support.

The Faith Community Receives

A Faith Build allows a way to put faith into action, calling people to serve in the way that the original apostles served. Many note revitalization throughout the congregation, an increase in membership and giving as people aspire to be a part of a vibrant Faith Community that reaches beyond itself. This is an effective way to engage small groups, young professionals, college and career groups, etc.

- Collaboration** A concrete way to put their faith into action. A Faith Build project calls people to leave the pews of the Faith Community.
- Community** An effective way to engage small groups within your congregation.
- Celebration** The opportunity for the entire Faith Community to be a part of the best part of Habitat - the home dedication where we gather to pray for the new homeowner and present them with a Bible and the key to their new home.



Partners in building better futures. Thrivent and Habitat for Humanity help families in need of a safe and decent place to call home. Who are we building for? Together we are helping families enjoy a successful future by providing affordable housing to hard-working, local families and individuals.

Striving to overcome standard maintenance issues that can affect the stability of homes and low-income families.

Home Preservation Programs

A Brush with Kindness - up to \$2,500

Qualified Repairs Include:

Exterior only: Landscaping, Exterior painting, Minor exterior repairs, Pressure washing
Hurricane shutters, Screen repair/replacement, Exterior handicap ramps

Mobile and manufactured homes qualify

Homeowner Contribution: 20% of cost

“Aging in Place” Modifications - up to \$10,000

Qualified Repairs Include:

Ramps or accessibility upgrades designed to accommodate physical mobility limitations

Mobile and manufactured homes do not qualify. Eligible for persons 65 and older.

Homeowner Contribution: 20% of cost

Weatherization - up to \$5,000

Qualified Repairs Include:

Window replacement, Insulation, Air conditioning replacement, Exterior door replacement,
Water heater wrap, Weather stripping

Mobile and manufactured homes do not qualify

Homeowner Contribution: Interest free loan on a sliding scale

Critical Home Repair - up to \$10,000

Qualified Repairs Include:

Roof replacement, Septic repair/replacement, Bathroom repairs, Kitchen repairs,
ADA modifications

Mobile and manufactured homes do not qualify

Homeowner Contribution: Interest free loan on a sliding scale and 8 volunteer hours

Repair Corps Program for Veterans - amount varies

Qualified Repairs Include:

Critical home repair and/or home preservation is available to ALL military veterans,
honorable or general discharge.

Mobile and manufactured homes qualify

Homeowner Contribution: Interest free loan on a sliding scale and 8 volunteer hours
